Your attention is drawn to the rights of Appeal set out on the attached sheet.

If the tree(s) overhang or straddle land in different ownerships you are advised to discuss your proposals with other owners of the tree, and for the avoidance of doubt, this consent does not give you any right to go onto your neighbours land in order to carry out the work.

Nesting birds and bats, their roosts and their access to these roosts are protected under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. Should birds be nesting in the trees concerned it is recommended that felling/surgery should be carried out between September and January for further advice contact Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust on 0115 9588248. If bats are present you should contact English Nature on 01476 568431.

**RIGHTS OF APPEAL**

If the applicant is aggrieved by the decision of the Borough Council to impose conditions on the grant of consent, then he or she may appeal to the Secretary of State under Section 78 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within twenty eight days of receiving this notice.

### **DESCRIPTION**

POLLARD TWO LIME TREES TO FRONT

### **SITE AND SURROUNDINGS**

The application site is flat and comprises part of the front garden of No.64 Derby Road. The site is located on the north-east of Derby Road with the dwellinghouse being located in the centre of the plot and comprising a detached property with areas of hard standing and garden. There are a number of trees within the immediate vicinity which are also subject to a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

### **APPLICATION DETAILS**

Permission is sought to pollard two lime trees back to the previous pollard point of 4 metres. The trees are subject to a Tree Preservation Order (numbered T4 and T5 respectively) and are located in the front garden area to the south-west of the dwellinghouse abutting the boundary with the public highway.

### **CONSULTATIONS**

Tree Consultant (Derby City Council, Arboricultural Manager) – No objection to the proposal subject to the trees being pollarded back to the previous pollard points only.

### **REPRESENTATIONS**

Site notice displayed. Advertised on the Planning weekly list. No representations have been received.

### **CONSIDERATIONS**

In response to the application for works to the protected trees, the Borough Council's Tree Consultant raised no objections to the proposal subject to the trees being pollarded back to the previous pollard point of 4 metres only (as proposed). Accordingly the application to carry out the works, subject to the standard conditions, is approved.
